

Safety is an essential element when it comes to our vehicles and their



ITINERARY

 Sesriem is a small settlement found in the Namib Desert. Visit the Sesriem Canyon. The Canyon is a natural canyon carved in the sedimentary rock.

Day 6: Sesriem
 An early departure will give you the opportunity to climb the majestic Dune 45 during the cooler time of the day. Explore Sossusvlei and Deadvlei.

Day 7: Sesriem to Swakopmund
 Continue to Swakopmund with its cooler Atlantic sea air, cultural experiences, and options for some extreme adventures like quad biking, sand boarding, 4x4 safaris, skydiving (weather permitting) and more.

Day 8: Swakopmund
 Swakopmund's wide variety of things to see and do caters for a wide scope of tastes and styles.



Our unique Polaris All-Terrain Vehicles allow you to experience that perfect moment where you make a true connection with Africa. Travel to Sesriem and Sossusvlei before returning to Windhoek.

ITINERARY

Day 1: Windhoek

Explore Windhoek during the day and meet your group and your Tour Leader in the evening at 18:00 to get acquainted and review your trip details.

Day 2: Windhoek to Etosha National Park

Depart after breakfast for Etosha National Park, one of Southern Africa's best-loved wildlife sanctuaries. Head out for an afternoon game drive to search for wildlife.

Day 3: Etosha National Park

Enjoy a full day's game drive in our Premium Overland Safari Vehicle. Gather memories of unique sights that you will not likely experience again.

Day 4: Etosha National Park to Kamanjab

We overnight about 20 km outside Kamanjab on a family farm. This extraordinary place offers guided tours around an authentic Himba village.

Day 5: Kamanjab to Brandberg (UIS Area)

We travel south to Brandberg which is home to Königstein, at 2,573m above sea level the highest peak in Namibia. We visit the famous White Lady Bushmen painting in the Brandberg on a guided self-drive tour with our Polaris Utility Terrain Vehicles (UTV).

Day 6: Brandberg to Swakopmund

Continue to Swakopmund with its cooler Atlantic sea air, cultural experiences, and options for some extreme adventures like quad biking, sand boarding, 4x4 safaris, skydiving (weather permitting) and more.

Day 7: Swakopmund

Swakopmund's wide variety of things to see and do caters for a wide scope of tastes and styles. If adrenalin and outdoors is your thing then you can enjoy optional activities like quad biking, sand boarding, 4x4 safaris, skydiving (weather permitting) and more.

Day 8: Swakopmund to Sesriem

Today is an early departure and a long drive south to the Namib Desert. You will be surrounded mostly by the wide-open Namibian landscape with spectacular scenery.

Day 9: Sesriem

Visit Sesriem Canyon and climb the majestic Dune 45 before continuing to the entrance of Sossusvlei/Deadvlei, a seemingly endless expanse of sand dunes.

Day 10: Sesriem to Windhoek

We return to Windhoek. Our last goodbye, a healthy breakfast, and the end of another incredible tour (tour ends at 16:00 in Windhoek).





8 DAYS OKAVANGO DELTA & VICTORIA FALLS

**TRAVEL FROM WINDHOEK, NAMIBIA VIA
BOTSWANA TO THE VICTORIA FALLS IN ZIMBABWE**

You will begin your eight-day journey of discovery in Namibia and finish at the Victoria Falls in Zimbabwe. This tour delivers an unforgettable experience as you walk with the San (Bushmen), do a Mokoro excursion in the Okavango Delta, and soak up the incredible views of Victoria Falls.

ITINERARY

Day 1: Windhoek
Explore Windhoek during the day and meet your group and your tour leader in the evening at 18:00 to get acquainted and review your trip details.

Day 2: Windhoek to Ghanzi
Depart Windhoek early for a long drive through the eastern part of Namibia, crossing the border into Botswana and travelling into the heart of the Kalahari Desert. Ghanzi is the farm where the San (Bushmen) live. In the evening enjoy an optional ancient dance ritual

performed around a campfire by the San and if the night is clear, enjoy the sparkling, starry skies for which Ghanzi is famous.

Day 3: Ghanzi to Maun
Enjoy a morning walk with the San (Bushmen) as they display their survival skills that have been passed on from generation to generation before departing Ghanzi and arriving in Maun. Once you arrive in Maun you will have the option to get a spectacular birds-eye view of the Okavango Delta from

above in a small fixed wing aircraft (weather permitting).

Day 4: Maun (Okavango Delta)
Today you experience a new way of travelling into the Okavango Delta with a mokoro, the same way as the local people do. A mokoro is a traditional dug-out canoe that seats two people. Your engine is a human being called a poler. Gliding along on the quiet water you will have an unlimited source of opportunities to take stunning pictures of your surroundings.

Day 4: Mokoro Day Trip (Optional Fly-in)
You have the option to go on a 1-day fly-in safari into the Okavango Delta. This is accessible by light aircraft only, a 20-minute flight from Maun.

Day 5: Maun to Elephant Sands
Elephant Sands is famous for its watering hole, voted as one of the top ten watering holes in Africa. Here you can expect to see animals such as wild dogs, different antelope species and of course elephants that walk through the campsite searching for fresh water.

Day 6: Elephant Sands to Chobe River (Kasane)
Relish the views during your included afternoon sunset boat cruise. Take your own sundowner with you as you look for wildlife on the banks of the Chobe River.

Chobe River (Kasane) to Victoria Falls (Zimbabwe)
Today you will have time to do some of the action-filled activities that the area offers. Bungee jump or gorge swing off the Victoria Falls Bridge that links Zambia and Zimbabwe and have a different view of the Victoria Falls at the same time. Book a day or two extra in Victoria Falls to make the most of your stay.

Day 8: Zimbabwe (Victoria Falls)
Our last goodbye, a healthy breakfast, and the end of another incredible tour.

This extraordinary guided tour leads you through spectacular highlights of Zimbabwe, starting in Victoria Falls continuing to Hwange National Park, Matobo National Park and finally onto Johannesburg. Explore the wildlife, nature, and beauty of Southern Africa in your Premium Overland Safari Vehicle (fitted with 12 Ultimate Safari Seats).



ITINERARY

Day 1: Victoria Falls

Tonight, the adventure begins but feel free to explore your surroundings before your welcome meeting. Your time in the small town of Victoria Falls can be filled with a variety of activities. You can also book an extra day or two pre-tour to make the most of your stay.

Day 2: Victoria Falls to Gwango (Hwange area)

After breakfast, we continue to Gwango situated just outside Hwange National Park, named after a local chief. Look forward to an included afternoon open vehicle game drive. After dinner, you can go on an optional night game drive which will give you the opportunity to discover nocturnal animals.

Day 3: Gwango (Hwange area) to Bulawayo

We head south towards Matobo National Park, which is at the Matobo or Matopos Hills, a scenic area of granite kopjes and wooded valleys. Banff Lodge, in the leafy suburb of Ilanda, Bulawayo will be your home for the next two nights.

Day 4: Bulawayo (Matobo National Park)

Enjoy a day full day game drive in the Matobo National Park. Visitors to Matobo National Park regularly spot white and black rhino, sable antelope, and impala, among other wildlife.

Day 5: Bulawayo to Musina

We cross the Zimbabwe / South Africa Border and overnight at the Bolayi Game Lodge. Klein Bolayi Game Lodge is set in the Limpopo Valley, in the heart of the world's largest concentration of Baobab trees, surrounded by fascinating granite outcrops in pristine bushveld vegetation.

Day 6: Musina to Johannesburg

Today you travel to Johannesburg. Book a day or two post tour to explore this fast-paced city. For the historically inclined there is the ever-popular Soweto tour or just jump on a Hop-On-Hop-Off bus to discover Johannesburg at your own pace. Tonight, you have the opportunity to dine in one of the many excellent restaurants the city offers.

Day 7: Johannesburg

Our last goodbye, a healthy breakfast, and the end of another incredible tour.





Day 1: Windhoek

Explore Windhoek during the day and meet your group and your Tour Leader in the evening at 18:00 to get acquainted and review your trip details.

Day 2: Windhoek to Ghanzi

Depart Windhoek early for a long drive through the eastern part of Namibia, crossing the border into Botswana and travelling into the heart of the Kalahari Desert. In the evening, you can enjoy an optional ancient dance ritual performed around a campfire by the San (Bushmen).

Day 3: Ghanzi to Maun

Enjoy an optional morning walk with the San (Bushmen) as they display their survival skills that have been passed on from generation to generation. Once you arrive in Maun you will have the option to get a spectacular birds-eye view of the Okavango Delta from above in a small fixed wing aircraft (weather permitting).

Day 4: Maun

Today you will experience a new way of travelling into the Okavango Delta with a mokoro, the same way as the local people do. A mokoro is a traditional dug-out canoe that seats two people. The mokoro is steered by a “poler” standing at the back, manoeuvring the

mokoro downstream with a pole, very much like the gondoliers in Venice.




